<i>Inca Empire</i>	<i>Started to rise in South America in Peru - 1200s</i>
<i>Where did they rule?</i>	<i>2,500 miles from present day Ecuador to southern Chile.</i>
<i>Sepa Inca</i>	<i>The emperor, claimed to be a descendent of the sun god.</i>
<i>Capital</i>	<i>Cuzco - home of the Temple of the Sun. Worshipped sun god.</i>
<i>3 factors that united the people</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="581 714 773 762">1. <i>Language</i> <li data-bbox="581 762 756 810">2. <i>Religion</i>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="581 806 1354 854">3. <i>Major highway system (Many still used today)</i>
<i>Record Keeping</i>	<i>No writing system. Used bright colored strings with knots to represent numbers and important information.</i>
<i>How did the Inca's ensure everyone had enough food ear and roads to travel?</i>	<i>Developed a highly organized government, collected a labor tax to feed population and maintain public works.</i>
